EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2021 - 033

AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2020 -062 "CREATING THE SAFETY AND HEALTH COMMITTEE OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT OF MONKAYO, DAVAO DE ORO AND ADOPTING THE GUIDELINES IN THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE OCCUPATIONAL SAFETY AND HEALTH STANDARDS FOR THE PUBLIC SECTOR" THEREBY REORGANIZING THE SAFETY AND HEALTH COMMITTEE OF THIS LOCAL GOVERNMENT

WHEREAS, Section 15, Article II of the Philippine Constitution of 1987 provides that the State shall protect and promote the right to health of the people and instill health consciousness among them. Further, Article XIII, Section 3 provides that the State shall afford full protection to labor, local and overseas, organized and unorganized and promote full employment and equality of employment opportunities for all;

WHEREAS, it is thereby expressly mandated that local governments are charged with the promotion of health and safety within their respective jurisdictions. As such, this local government must take the lead in the prevention, mitigation, preparedness and continuing containment of the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) at the local level to include in the local government's workplace, offices and establishments it operates;

WHEREAS, in compliance with Joint Memorandum Circular No. 1, s. 2020 issued by the Civil Service Commission and Department of Health, the local government of Monkayo created its own Safety and Health Committee in accordance with the prescribed composition as mandated under the same directive through Executive Order No. 2020-062 dated November 16, 2021;

WHEREAS, due to the greater and increasing risk of the COVID-19 pandemic imposed by the workers of this local government, it is inherent upon to the same to strengthen its existing safety and health mechanisms through the active and fully functional health and safety committee, and that its functions and duties are well carried out;

WHEREAS, with this notion it is imperative to amend the existing executive order to reorganize the existing composition of the Health and Safety Committee of the local government. This shall in turn provide an efficient and effective implementation of occupational safety and health standards to protect all government employees from the hazards of injury, sickness and other forms of danger;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, **RAMIL L. GENTUGAYA**, Municipal Mayor, Municipality of Monkayo, Davao de Oro, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby **ORDER AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2020 -062 "CREATING THE SAFETY AND HEALTH COMMITTEE OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT OF MONKAYO, DAVAO DE ORO AND ADOPTING THE GUIDELINES IN THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE OCCUPATIONAL SAFETY AND HEALTH STANDARDS FOR THE PUBLIC SECTOR" THEREBY REORGANIZING THE SAFETY AND HEALTH COMMITTEE OF THIS LOCAL GOVERNMENT**

FUNCTIONS:

1. Coordinate with the appropriate bodies for support and referral to community-based isolation facilities for confirmed cases with mild symptoms, and to health facilities for severe and critical care;
2. Undertake contact tracing or coordinate the conduct thereof;
3. Monitor status of employees quarantined or isolated; and
4. Implement return to work policies

SECTION III. GENERAL PROVISIONS. All other sections and provisions of Executive Order No. 2020-062 dated November 16, 2020 which created the Health and Safety Committee and which established and institutionalized the guidelines in the implementation of the Occupational Safety and Health Standards for the public sector, shall remain effective and enforced.

SECTION IV. EFFECTIVITY. This Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain in full force unless otherwise amended, modified or repealed accordingly.
